In June 2009 Kidde **recalled dual sensor smoke alarms, and fire extinguishers** for product failure reasons. On December 22, 2004, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission and GE Security, Inc. announced **a voluntary recall of approximately 246,800 smoke detectors** with certain control panels that also failed to activate during a fire or an emergency. The fire safety recalls mentioned above are a small sample of fire safety products that are a threat to consumer safety.

With your help, we can keep the public informed about consumer safety information. Thanks again!
